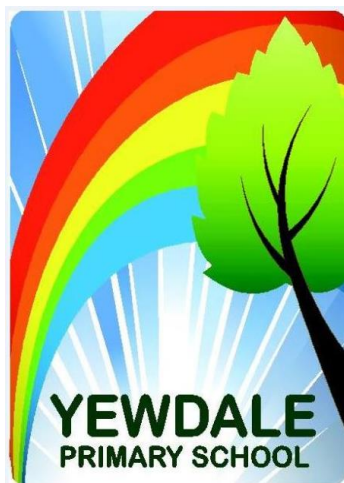

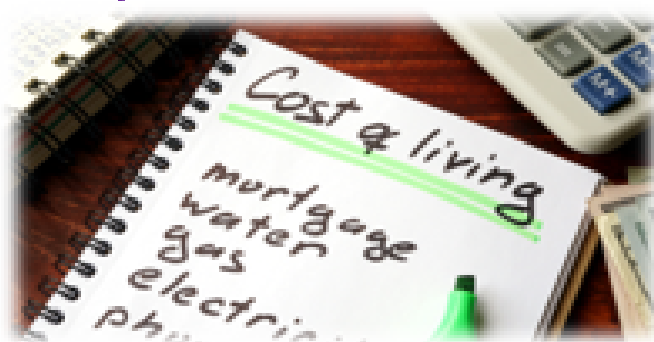
You will not be asked about your own financial position or be expected to share private information.
